A round table on the topic of the "Animal Health Act - the role of the veterinary medicine profession in the strategy for animal health" will be held, as well as a discussion within the Veterinary Public Health section on the topic of "New legislative framework in the field of food safety - What the new Food Act and the Act on Microbiological Criteria for Food and their accompanying legislation brings us".

In particular, we would like to point out that, within the Veterinary Public Health section, there will be a discussion on the new changes to the organisation of the National RASFF System and the Crisis Management Plan in the field of food and animal feed, sampling carcasses, minced meat and meat preparations, as well as the conditions and manner of reducing the number of basic sampling units in facilities with lower production capacity, as well as the microbiological classification and special rules for live bivalve mollusc hygiene.

In addition to the above, two sections will discuss topics from the field of small animals practice (internal medicine, surgery, radiology, and parasitology) and one section will discuss topics from large animals practice, within which several lectures will be held on the topic of mastitis prevention and treatment.

I sincerely hope that the listed topics from various fields of veterinary science and the veterinary profession are a good reason for your participation in the conference and that the active participation in discussions will contribute to the success of the conference and drawing of conclusions that will benefit veterinary medicine and the veterinary profession as a whole.

Finally, despite the conference's extensive programme, I hope that there will be enough time for collegial socializing and exchanging valuable experiences, all in a pleasant atmosphere provided by the Plava Laguna Hotel and the city of Poreč.
